STUDENT AWARDS AND RECOGNITION

GENERALLY

The School Board approves of awards for students who achieve high academic standing, outstanding citizenship, physical expertise and other characteristics. The School Board, however, does not approve of giving awards to students when the basic purpose is obviously commercialism. Awards sponsored by an agency outside the schools that are recognized nationally and/or that are approved by the Board may be given to students at appropriate ceremonies and times as the Superintendent approves. Only awards for exceptional achievements may be given at graduation ceremonies.

HONOR ROLLS

Students' academic achievements shall be honored and given public recognition by the posting and release to the public of the names of students making the Honor Roll. The criteria for achieving this honor shall be established by the Superintendent and shall be based solely upon the academic excellence achieved during a stated period.

OTHER AWARDS

The Board approves of the use of awards in the schools as an incentive to students. Awards and honors shall be open to all students and should be designed to permit a wide range of success experiences for students at all levels.

BOARD RECOGNITION OF STUDENT ACHIEVEMENTS

The Board shall make efforts to publicly acknowledge outstanding achievements of students and staff.
