

## ADVANCED PLACEMENT CLASSES AND SPECIAL PROGRAMS

King George County Schools will notify students and their parents of the availability of dual enrollment and advanced placement classes; career and technical education programs, including internships, externships, apprenticeships, credentialing programs, certification programs, licensure programs, Academic Year Governor's School Programs; and other work-based learning experiences. The qualifications for enrolling in such classes, programs, and experiences; and the availability of financial assistance to low-income and needy students to take the advanced placement examinations. Students and their parents are also notified of the program with a community college to enable students to complete an associate's degree or a one-year Uniform Certificate of General Studies concurrent with a high school diploma.

Specifically, information concerning pre-requisite coursework and/or other qualifications for accessing such opportunities will be made available via the school division website and through high and middle school guidance offices. To facilitate general interest and clear communication regarding the Governor's School Programs available to King George County students, the district will annually host at least one evening presentation to review specific qualifications, procedures and timelines for making application to such programs.

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
