

STUDENT SOCIAL EVENTS

Student Social Events

The development of the students' social skills is among the objectives of the School Board. The Board permits a reasonable number of social events for students to be held after school hours. Social events, including dances and parties, may be held with the permission of the school principal and shall be planned and sponsored by a school association, club or organization. The principal shall establish rules to ensure adequate student controls. Parents, teachers, and adult community members should be encouraged to attend these events as additional chaperons and to set an example for student conduct.

The scheduling of social events shall not interfere with regular school activities and they shall terminate at an appropriate hour. Evening events should be scheduled at the beginning of the weekend, during the weekend or immediately preceding a holiday.

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
