Variance FAQs – King George County Schools

Do I need to fill out a new Variance Request Form for this school year if I was approved for the last school year? Yes.

If I am a new family registering in King George and I am requesting a variance do I need to fill out a Variance Request Form? Yes. Please contact your zoned school of residence to complete the registration process. You will submit your variance request to the registrar at that time.

If my student(s) is in the gifted or special education program at King George Elementary School, do I need to fill out a Variance Request Form for a sibling to attend? Yes. You will need to fill out a Variance Request Form for the current school year. The sibling's variance request will be approved, space permitting.

If I had a student(s) attending a school with an approved variance from the previous school year, and the approved student has a sibling that I prefer to attend the same school, do I need to submit a variance request for the current school year? Yes. The sibling's variance request will be approved, space permitting.

Do I need to provide transportation if I am requesting a variance? Yes. It will be the parent/guardian's responsibility to ensure daily transportation to and from school.

There is a question located on the Employee Variance Request Application that asks if I am a KGCS Permanent Employee Resident or KGCS Permanent Non-Resident. What does this mean?

A KGCS Permanent Employee Resident or a KGCS Permanent Employee Non-Resident means that as a KGCS employee I would need to be a continually employed employee, who reports on a regular basis as opposed to an employee who is hired on an as-needed basis - such as substitutes and seasonal coaches/sponsors.
